Thank you for meeting with _____ on Friday, August 22. I appreciate you taking the time to discussion with her my employment situation with the Lee County School District.

I also wanted to clarify a few things regarding my employment history with the LCSD...

1) all but one of my employment releases were at the suggestion of the individual administrator and was done simply because I was still in my probationary period. I feel I am being penalized for something that I had no control over, since it was not my choice to leave those positions.

2) I was employed at a charter school from 8/8/23 – 10/28/24, and was in the process of being promoted to full-time (salaried), when I was terminated simply because I was deemed “ineligible for rehire” by the LCSD.

3) I am currently being denied employment by Kelly Education (Services) as a substitute teacher because KE claims, “I did not pass district criteria”. Can you please tell me what district criteria I did not pass in order to be a substitute teacher in Lee County Schools.
